For the 2026 school year, families are kindly asked to provide their child's stationery items. The school is pleased to continue supporting students by supplying exercise books and key learning resources. All Prep student stationery and resources are supplied by school.

ESSENTIAL PURCHASES REQUIRED FOR YEAR 1 - 9:

- 1 Pencil case
- 4 Glue Sticks
- 1 Pair of Scissors - Left hand scissors if necessary
- 4 Erasers (white soft)
- 2 boxes HB Pencils
- 2 x blue, black and red pens
- 4 pack of highlighters
- 1 Packet coloured pencils
- 1 Packet wind-ups Crayons (Primary years 1-4 only)
- 1 Packet felt pens
- 1 Ruler – **wooden ruler is recommended**
- 1 Pencil Sharpener (within a plastic container)
- 1 Old Shirt – painting/construction work— Named
- 1 Material Drawstring Bag for Library Books

As stationery is used, replacements will need to be purchased. Reminders will go home.

- *Protective shoes (Closed in, non-slip sneakers) are required for some subjects for safety reasons – Manual Arts, Agriculture, Science & Home Economics.*

Resources and Textbook Hire Scheme

If students elect **not** to join our Resources & Textbook Hire Scheme, they will be required to provide their own resources and textbooks. These will cover costs for subjects such as Technologies (Digital, Home Economics, Manual Arts, Agriculture), Science, Maths, English and Arts which all students will complete in 2026.

Proposed Camps & Excursions

Throughout the year, students will have the opportunity to participate in a range of valuable school excursions and incursions designed to enrich their learning beyond the classroom. These experiences play an important role in deepening students' understanding of key concepts, fostering personal growth, and building real-world connections to the curriculum. As a school, we recognise the importance of making these opportunities accessible to all families, and we will endeavour to subsidise the cost of these activities wherever possible. If there are any costs to families, parents and carers will be informed in a timely manner to allow for adequate planning and support. Families in Prep – year 6 will have Qld Government Back to School Boost, which provides a \$100 credit for each Primary student from 2026. A \$100 credit will be placed on a student's account and families can select school related expenses they wish to use them from such as excursions and camps. Please note that the Back to School Boost cannot be used for reimbursements made at external stores, nor can it be provided as a cash payment. We will provide the opportunity for your \$100 credit to access your Back to School Boost for school related expenses throughout the year.
